Sometimes, it seems impossible to "do it all." While we are focusing this fall on things we can DO as disciples of Jesus, remember that the primary concern of God is first how we are BEING disciples of Jesus.

We are claimed, loved, and saved by Christ through our faith. Faith, before any actions, starts with trust. No matter how busy we are, we can wake up with a quick prayer of thanks and put our trust in God's hands for the day. When we end our full days exhausted, we place ourselves in God's hands. So when you are wondering how you can "do it all" or if you are doing anything at all to make a difference in a hurting world, don't lose heart! All our "doing" helps our "being" followers of Jesus. Jesus has already given us his all and will carry us through.


# **Church Library Makeover**
