From the Pastor's Desk

This summer is a season of anniversaries! You'll see in this newsletter photos from our celebration of Pastor Jim Anderson's 50th anniversary of ordination last month. Most of my vacation this year is being taken in August to celebrate my parents' 50th wedding anniversary. This July 4, we celebrate the 250th anniversary of our country. You may be celebrating anniversaries of your own this summer, too: congratulations, and God's blessings to you! In our gospel readings for the summer, Jesus focuses on describing the gift of the kingdom of heaven for us as his disciples. His coming into the world begins a new era, and his teachings build on the Jewish faith tradition. With any anniversary, we are looking back at what God has done for us and through us in the past, and then building on that treasure to fulfill what plans God might have for our future.

When it comes to our faith, any anniversary is a stewardship opportunity – and I'm not just talking about giving money to the church. We take time to look at what amazing gifts God has given us in a marriage, in the gift of our country as Americans, in the gift of our church as people of Faith. Giving thanks for the gifts we have, we pray about how we might use these gifts faithfully. We don't just look back to what is old; we look forward to what is new. We don't just look inward thinking only of ourselves (as a couple, as a church, or as a nation), we look to how we can bless our larger family, our community and our world. This is why when it comes to celebrating our church's anniversary in particular, we are planning events where you can invite people (friends, neighbors, family members) to join us, or where we go out to be present in our community. Certainly, this summer, there is great treasure to share in the gifts we have received from God! May we use this treasure faithfully and wisely, for the sake of God's kingdom.

Every year, show business presents its super stars to the world. These are the entertainers who have survived all the preliminary rounds in the search for talent. They have been chosen because they are tops in ability and charisma.

God conducts a continuous talent search also, but the process is different. In this talent search all are participants; no one is merely a spectator.

All performers are under scrutiny, not to see whether some are better than others, but to examine the manner in which they are using their talents. The main questions are:

To what purpose are they devoting their talents?

Do they thank God for giving them all their abilities?

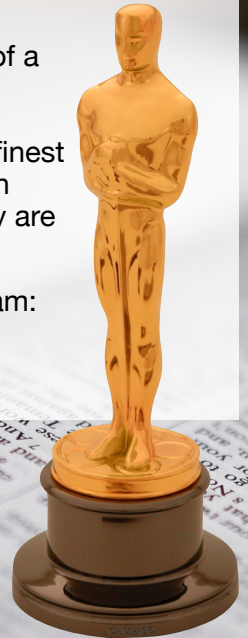
Do they envy the talents of others or do they thank God for these gifts also?

I know a little about Syosset because my husband worked in Woodbury, NY. We would occasionally drive through Syosset. At that time, we lived in Harlem, New York and he would drive to work from Harlem to Woodbury five and sometimes six days a week. After five years of commuting, we moved to Uniondale, NY. I never thought I would be back in Syosset after my husband died. Yet God has allowed me to come back to work in this town and be part of this community at Faith Lutheran Church. Sometimes God takes us back to places where we never thought that we would ever go back. Yet God has brought me back to this town. Like the story of

Naomi, God brings us back to places where we encounter God in a new way.

The book of Ruth tells the story about a woman named Naomi. There was a famine in the land of Judah and Naomi, her husband and two children went to live in the country of Moab. Naomi's husband died and also her two sons. She heard that there was food in Judah and she left Moab and went back to Judah. When the people of Judah met her, Naomi told them, don't call me Naomi but call me Mara. Naomi means "pleasant" and Mara means "bitter." Naomi told the people "call me Mara, for the almighty has dealt bitterly with me. I went away full, but the Lord has brought me back empty" (Ruth 1:20-21). At the end of the story, Naomi was restored. Her daughter-in-law had a child who was the grandfather of King David. The Lord was indeed the "restorer of life and a nourisher" (Ruth 4:15) to Naomi.


God has brought me back to this area and I wait to see what God will do while I am here at Faith Lutheran Church in Syosset, NY.

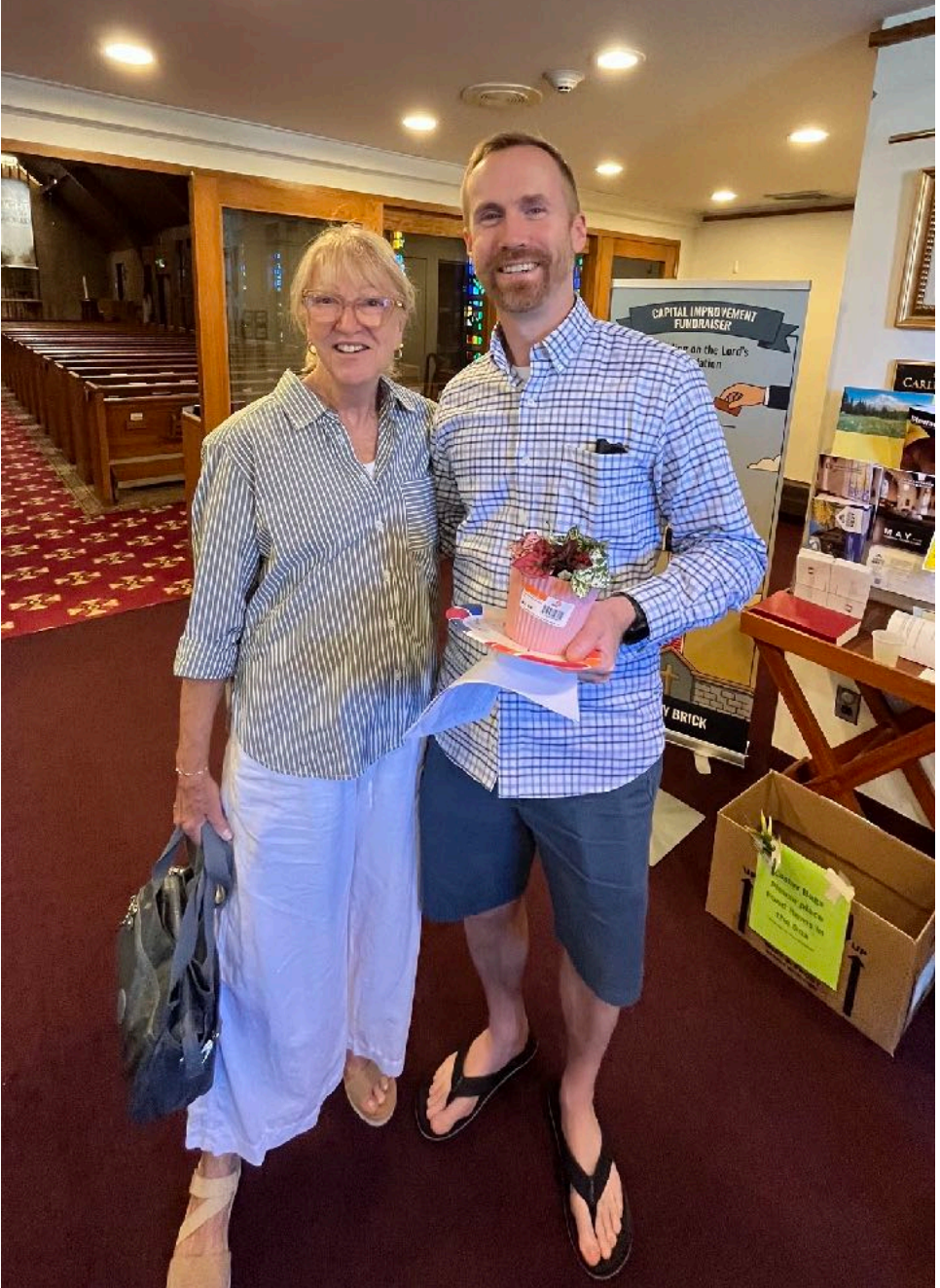
