*From the Pastor's Desk*

As you may know, regularly during our Sunday morning worship we have a time for "mission moments" as well as "God sightings." Jesus has proclaimed that the kingdom of heaven has come near as we experience the work of the Holy Spirit in our communities today, through us! He sends us out to receive God's blessings and share God's blessings with a world in need. He promises that he lives through us to equip us to do this work.

With everything going on in the world around us, it can be difficult to believe that we can still see glimpses of God's work in the world, or even more so, the kingdom of heaven breaking into our ordinary lives. Naming how God is at work in our lives is so important to sustain our hope and faith in God's goodness. June is a time where we experience many "God sightings" – the kingdom of heaven coming near to us. We are welcoming a new Vicar (the title for a pastor-in-training) who will be with us for one year, full-time, doing ministry alongside us. We are celebrating Pastor Jim Anderson's 50th anniversary of ordination, a servant of God who has blessed many congregations in our Eastern Nassau Conference over decades. We are blessing our graduates from fifth grade all the way up to college. We are thanking our Heavenly Father for the blessing of our fathers and father-figures in our lives. You may be celebrating weddings, confirmations, or other family celebrations of your own, as well! In these joyful days, may we recognize God's work among us and be encouraged that Christ continues to bring the kingdom of heaven near to us.

***It seems as if nobody can get enough these days.***

Everywhere I go I overhear people saying: "If only I could get a \$100 raise." "If only I could have just one more dress." How many times have you heard someone make such a statement? How many times have you said it yourself? If only ... if just ... one more ... just one more.

Doesn't it seem as if people never get enough? Sure there's inflation and prices keep going up, but that's not the whole story. There's something about people. They always want more. It makes you wonder. When is enough ever going to be enough? Where does the desire for more end?

I was musing in this vein when I was suddenly struck by a thought: There is something that people seem to be able to get enough of! Ask them how much they should pledge to their church. They'll come up with an idea of what is enough in a flash. Often it is token giving. Ask them how much of their time, talents and energy they should give to their church. For most people an occasional hour seems enough. Strange isn't it, how most of us can figure out very quickly, how much is enough for God.

If we are to be Christian stewards we must learn to think differently. We must first consider how much God has given to us. Has God ever stopped giving because God felt he had given enough? If God did stop giving, where would we be? A steward knows that all that they have is a gift from God. So the steward is always asking if they can do more for God. The steward donates freely of their time and talent, assisting wherever and whenever they can. The steward cultivates an attitude of generous giving, because they know the importance of their gift to God's work. Instead of wanting to have more, the steward wants to do more. Because they know that they can never do enough for God!

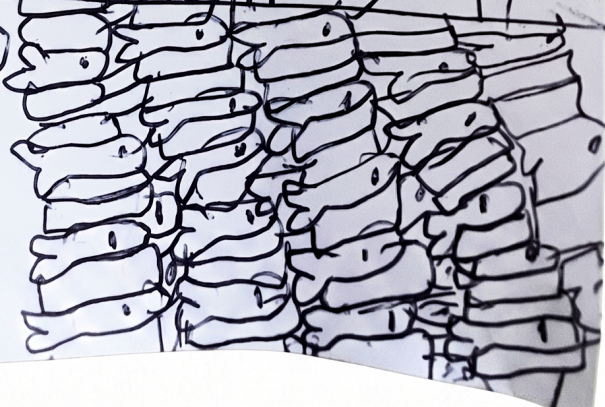

### **WELCA Women's Retreat - April 25th, 2026**

Michelle Chan was able to join the Synod's WELCA retreat and shared her reflections:

The Women of the ELCA [WELCA] President, Lisette Martinez welcomed all women from the Metro NY Synod to gather in worship and discussion on the importance of women in the Bible, with a central focus on St. Mary Magdalene. Hosted at Christ Lutheran Church in New Hyde Park, dozens of women, from ages 28 to 89, gathered to pay homage to all of the women who preceded them in Scripture and in the Synod.

Led by Pastor Dawn Morello, the retreat was a sacred time of listening, reflection, and honest conversation as much as it was about fellowship.

St. Mary Magdalene is a woman remembered not only for her devotion to Christ, but also for her courage and steadfast faith. Her story continues to resonate deeply

today. Mary Magdalene stood faithfully near the cross during a time of grief and uncertainty, and she became one of the first witnesses to the resurrection. Her story reminds us that even in moments of sorrow or darkness, God continues to bring hope, purpose, and new life.

That message echoed throughout the retreat as women shared thoughtful conversations about the many challenges they have endured throughout life, while also celebrating the resilience, wisdom, compassion, and spiritual strength they continue to embody every day.

Several discussions focused on the evolving role of women within the church and the importance of ensuring that women's voices, gifts, and leadership continue to be welcomed, encouraged, and uplifted. Conversations also reflected on the unseen burdens many women quietly carry — caring for loved ones, balancing careers and responsibilities, navigating personal hardships, and continuing to show strength for others even during difficult seasons of life.

Yet amid these meaningful conversations, there was also laughter, warmth, encouragement, and hope.

Faith does not erase hardship, but it reminds us that darkness never has the final word. Through community, prayer, and shared experiences, burdens become lighter and hope becomes easier to hold onto.

Just as Mary Magdalene faithfully carried the good news forward, women throughout our congregations continue to bear witness through service, leadership, compassion, resilience, prayer, and love. May we continue building communities where women feel seen, heard, encouraged, and empowered to walk boldly in faith.
